## **Our Vision**

Make Basketball more popular and widespread in Australia by providing quality training to players at an affordable cost to the community with care and compassion.

## **Training**

- Training time can be 1pm - 3 pm or 3 pm - 5pm on Saturdays or Sundays at Crestwood High School
- Training will be focused on fitness, skill development, team work and game time
- We have a young coaching squad of 2 Senior coaches (experienced) and 5 Junior Coaches.
- Players with exceptional leadership skills will be given the opportunity to become junior coaches as long as they play to Blazers

## **Team Structure and Competition Readiness**

- Only when the coaches recommend for the suitability to compete kids will be placed in competitions or tournaments
- If the kids joined from the Hornets notice board these kids to be allowed to play in the completion regardless
- Players to be placed in divisions appropriate to the standard of the kids and players to be trained accordingly

## Fees

- Blazers Training fees will be \$120 per term of 10 weeks - This is for 2 hours of training and the 1-hour competition per week.
- If not attending competitions only need to pay \$100
- Other than that there are Hornets Fees per term (is available at Hornets website)
- Uniform Costs approximately \$80 - once off payment
- NSW Basketball membership fee \$ 110 (annual)
- For convenience of the parents we collect all the fees except NSW Basketball registration and pay Hornets on behalf of parents.
- Parents will be informed the total fees to be paid, at the beginning of the term
- The payments to be paid in total at the beginning through a bank transfer. Account details will be emailed once registered.
- In specific situations, cash payments will be allowed
- Parents are allowed to pay in instalments if they have any hardships of paying at once.
- A receipt will be emailed for all the payments
- To give a hand to the parents who have difficulties of paying, we have introduced below.
  - a. When there are siblings - the remaining siblings to be given a 50% discount of Blazers Training cost
  - b. If any friend/relative /colleague is introduced to Blazers by another player a \$20 discount to be given for each player introduced until no cost of training.

## **Blazers Policies & Procedures**

### **General**

- Unless otherwise mentioned under Blazers' Policies & Procedures, Blazers will always follow the policies and procedures of NSW Basketball, any other competitions, Tournaments hosts or the place where Blazers uses the venues of

### **Player Game Time Policy**

- Each player to have reasonable and fair playing time on preliminary rounds of the competition.
- Coaches have the right to play some players more whenever they feel required
- In critical games semi-finals or finals – coaches may take decisions to play certain kids longer and others less

### **Complains**

- Complains need to be lodged through our website. Go to the Tab – Contacts and send yours complain or any other inquiries.
- Under no circumstances directly accuse or complain to junior coaches re any matter. They are kids.
- You can also email or directly contact the Club Manager, Head coach or any Senior Coach for any complain.

### **Photo Policy**

- Initial approval from the parents to take kids photos, to place them in any social media, web pages or any other advertising materials similar to flyers, banners etc.

### **Emergency Process**

- Collect information on registration, emergency contacts, any medical or other conditions that Blazers need to be aware of the kids to provide him a safer environment

### **Basketball NSW Registration**

All kids joining Blazers must be registered with NSW Basketball Association before commence training.

## Other Policies

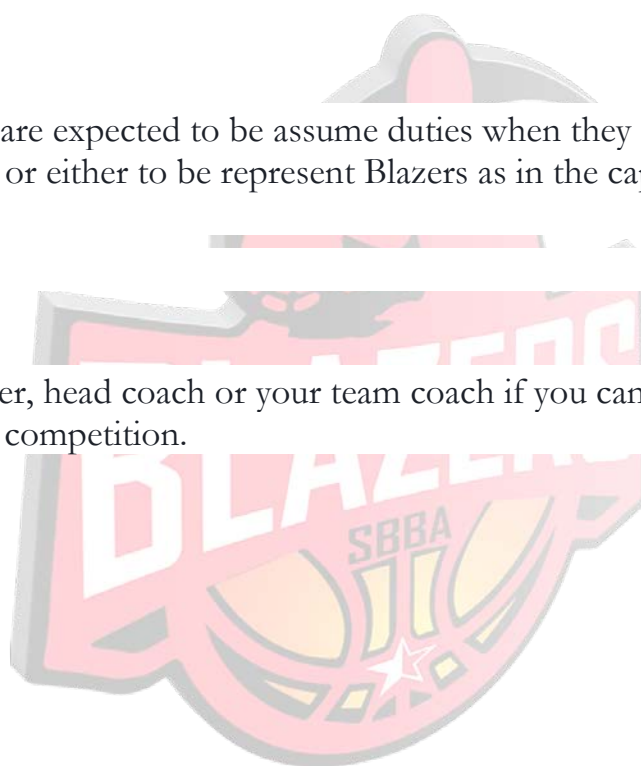
- Blazers have no discrimination in any kind and no bullying allowed.
